Examples of other enclosed public places where local governments have the authority to prohibit smoking and all tobacco use.

"Public Place" means an enclosed area to which the public is invited or in which the public is permitted. These types of places **can include but are not limited to**:

- 1. Banks
- 2. Private educational facilities
- 3. Gaming facilities (but not casinos on an Indian Reservation)
- 4. Health care facilities
- 5. Hotels and motels (except for any designated smoking guest room (no more than 20% of rooms may be designated as smoking)
- 6. Laundromats
- 7. Privately owned public transportation facilities
- 8. Reception areas
- 9. Grocery stores
- 10. Country stores
- 11. Convenience stores
- 12. Retail service establishments
- 13. Retail stores
- 14. Shopping malls
- 15. Indoor sports arenas
- 16. Indoor theaters
- 17. Veterinary offices
- 18. Dental offices
- 19. Waiting rooms
- 20. Vehicle sales, repair and maintenance facility
- 21. Bowling Alleys
- 22. Bingo Halls
- 23. Office Building Lobbies
- 24. Coffee Shops
- 25. A private residence that is also used as a child care, adult day care, or health care facility
